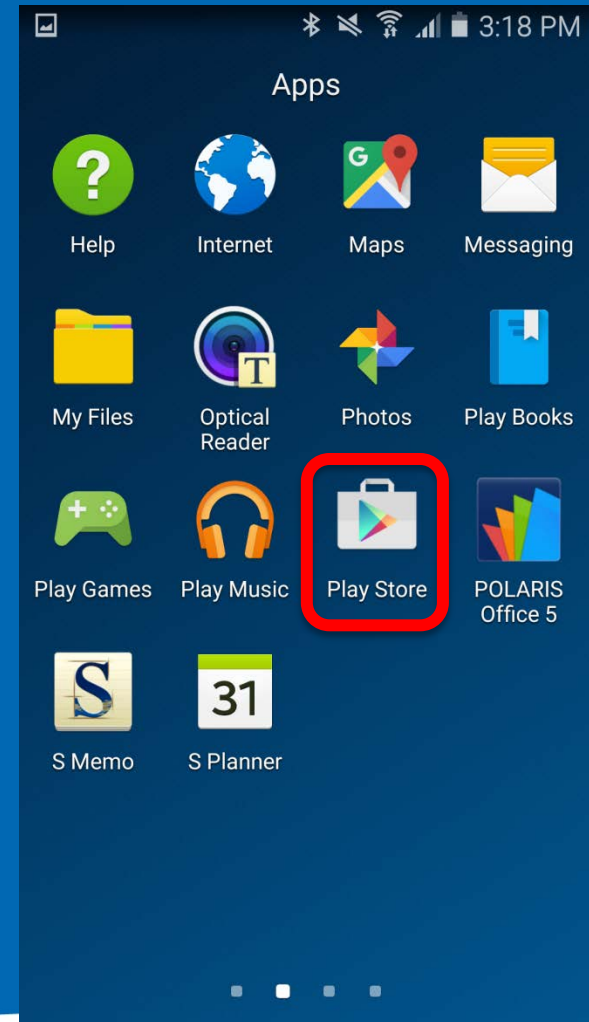
# What is the CFPC Mobile App?

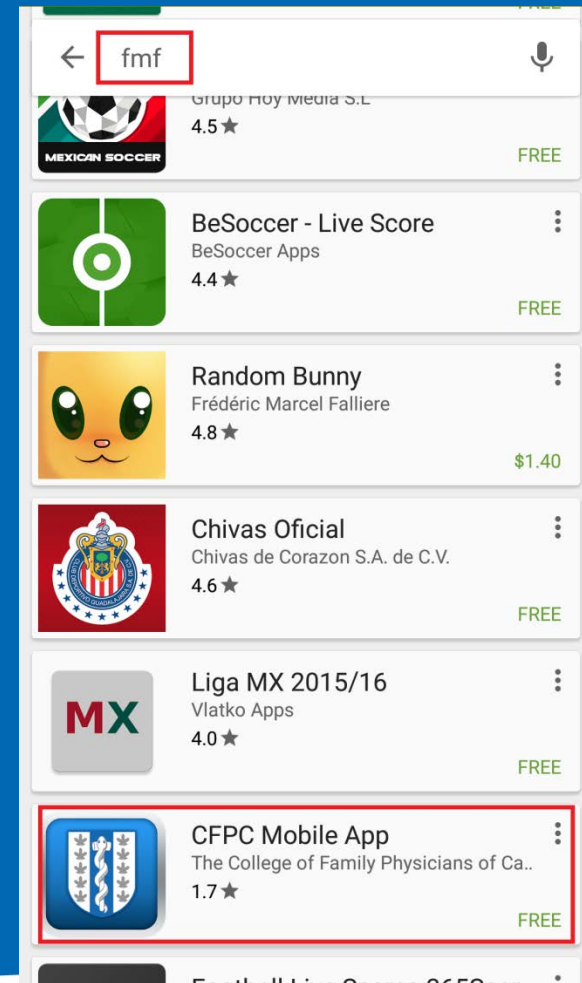
# How to download the CFPC app

1. Tap on **Play Store** in your device



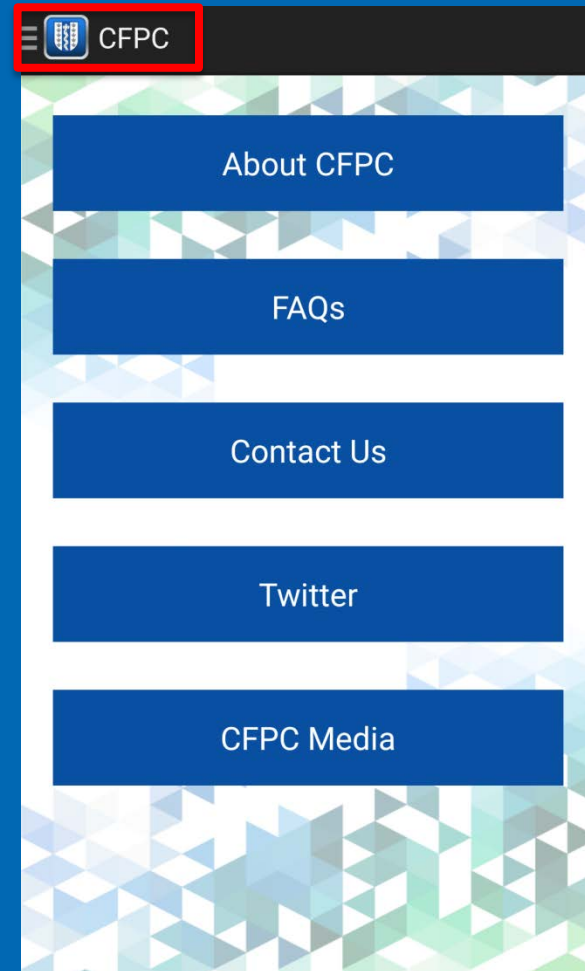
# How to download the CFPC app

3. After the download is complete, tap on **Open** to launch the app



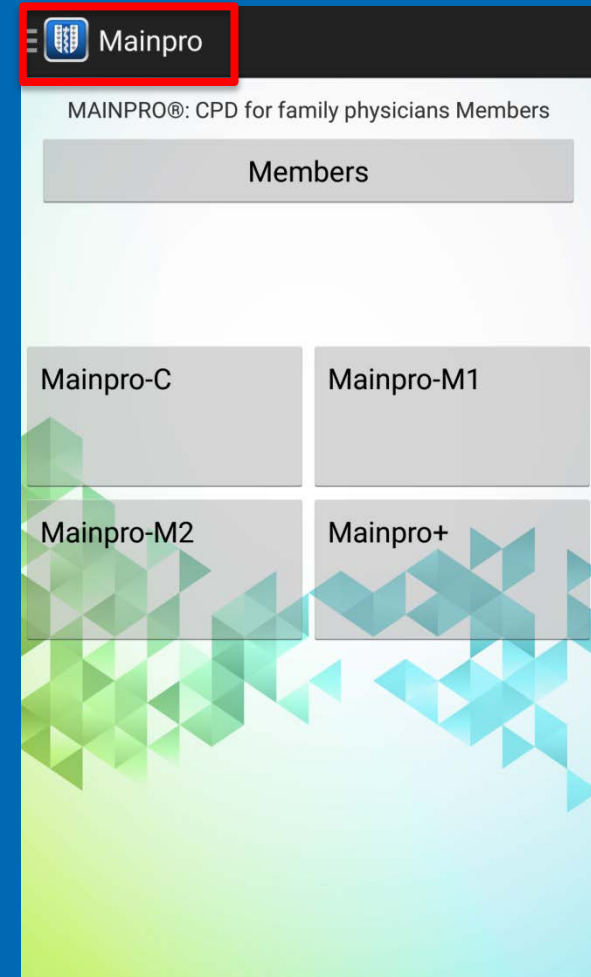
# CFPC Mobile App – Home

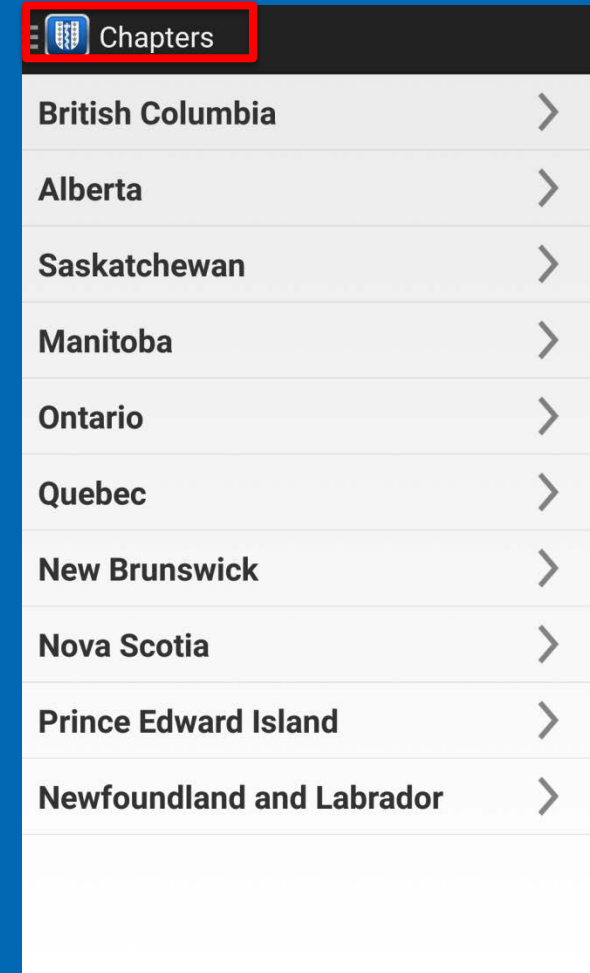

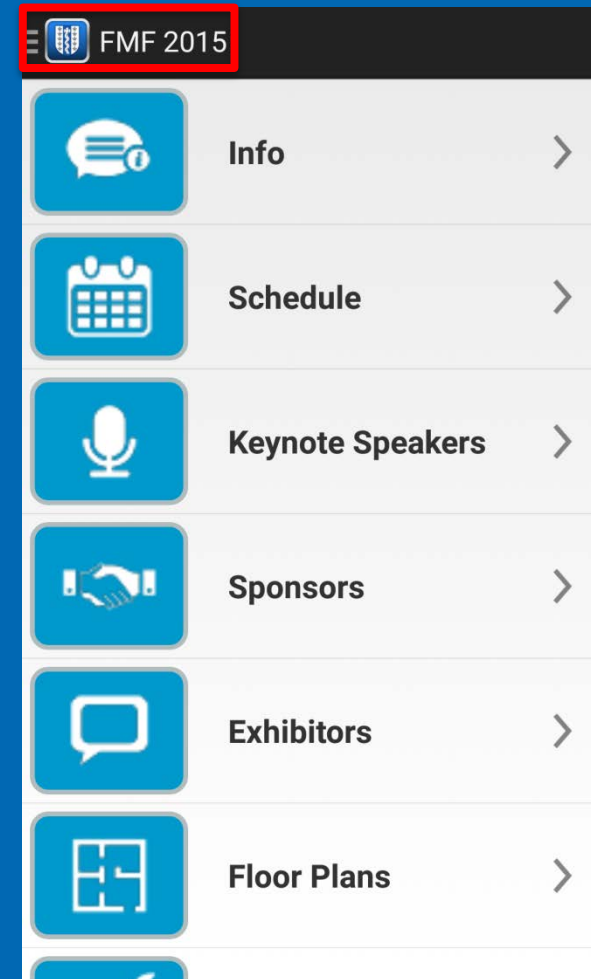

# CFPC Mobile App – FMF 2015

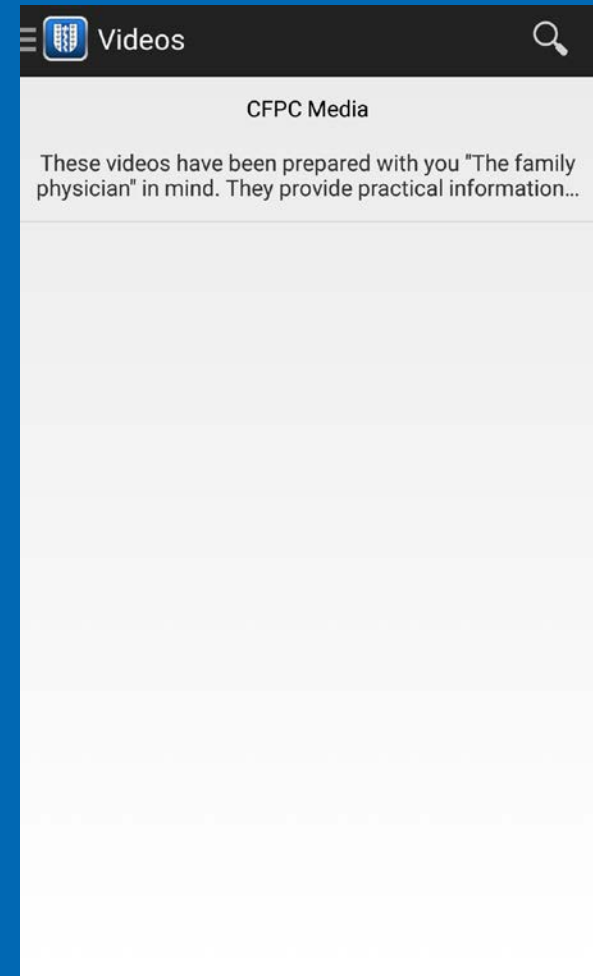
