

# FMF Poster Guidelines

1. All text and illustration on your poster should be in print large enough to be read from 1 meter (39") away.
2. When developing your poster, focus on its central theme. The central theme should be clear, direct, specific, and supported as concisely as possible. You should be able to condense the theme of your poster so that its overall message can be presented in few words and grasped quickly. Methodology and significant conclusions should be stated clearly and concisely.
3. All illustrations (graphs, tables, figures, equations) for your poster should be completed before you arrive. Although assistance will be available to help you mount your presentation on the display boards, there will be no materials on site at the FMF to help you create diagrams or charts for your presentation.
4. The language of presentation on all materials should be in either English and/or French.

Poster display board specifications: (INSIDE BOARD DIMENSION 86  $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide X 47" high). You must use hook and loop tape (i.e. Velcro) to affix your poster to this board. Please ensure that your poster materials fit within these dimensions, and that you have brought along sufficient Velcro for your poster. While we will have some backup supplies on hand, it is best that you arrive already prepared.

Poster title: Please ensure that the title of your poster, including the name(s) of the author(s) is clearly indicated. All that will be added to your poster on site is the number to identify your abstract in the final program. It is suggested that the lettering for your poster title should be not less than one inch in height.
