 - Two-step filtration system with a MERV 13 rating
 - Highly effective air filters in all HVAC systems
 - Increased cleaning frequency of the air handling units
 - The volume of fresh air intake has increased from 20 per cent up to 50 per cent
 - Running hours for air handling units extended to increase fresh air turnover

Mainpro+[®] Credit Information

This one-credit-per-hour Group Learning Program has been certified by the CFPC and the Ontario College of Family Physicians for up to 105 Mainpro+ credits.

Earn up to 24 Mainpro+ credits by attending in person and earn up to 81 Mainpro+ credits by participating virtually and accessing on-demand.

How do I report my credits?

You do **not** need to report credits for any sessions you attend at FMF either in person or virtually. These credits will be tracked and uploaded to your Mainpro+ holding area within six (6) weeks after the on-demand period ends.

Exception: Mainpro+ two- and three-credit-per-hour workshops held on November 8th and November 15th require completion of post-course work before attendees can claim those credits. These are not uploaded automatically.

How are credits tracked?

For in-person sessions, session monitors will scan your badge before you enter a session room.

Please ensure that your badge is scanned prior entering the room. If you miss being scanned while on-site at FMF, please visit the Session Scanning Questions desk at the registration area, level 600, MTCC.

iPhone/iPad

Open Safari and go to the FMF 2022 Pathable website (<u>https://hybridfmf2022.pathable.co/</u>). Tap the Share icon at the bottom, then tap Add to Home Screen from the menu. Next, type in a name for your shortcut (we suggest FMF 2022) and then tap the Add button.

Android Devices

Open Google Chrome and go to the FMF 2022 Pathable website (<u>https://hybridfmf2022.pathable.co/</u>). Then drop down the menu by tapping the three-dot icon at the top right-hand corner of the screen. Select "Add to Home Screen," and you're done.

Virtual FMF
