Family practice is critical in equipping patients with relevant information around disease prevention and immunization. Many Canadian adults at-risk of developing Herpes Zoster (HZ) remain unvaccinated and therefore are at risk of the painful, debilitating consequences of shingles. Multiple environmental factors play a role in a clinician's capacity to recommend immunizations. During this talk, speakers will lead practical discussions on how to identify patients at risk of developing HZ who may benefit from immunization (age, comorbidities, etc.), best practice and clinical tools to support patient counselling (including latest data on persistence of protection), as well as methods of improving communication along the patient pathway to ensure patients do not miss their opportunity to be protected are more relevant now than ever.
